### NRI CATEGORY SEATS FOR CHILDREN AND WARDS OF NRI

Few seats in the undergraduate/postgraduate programmes at some NIFT Campuses are likely to be available in the **NRI category for the Children and Wards of NRI**.

Status of the remaining seats of undergraduate/postgraduate programme B.Ftech and M.Ftech. is available at NIFT website. Status for the remaining seats of other UG/PG Programmes will be available on **20<sup>th</sup> July, 2017** after first round of regular counselling. Interested candidates may apply for these vacant seats in the NRI category. The applicants of above mentioned category, upon securing admission would be required to pay a sum of Rs.7,24,400/- (Rupees Seven lakh twenty four thousand and four hundred only) for the first academic year and other fees as per NIFT Rules for the subsequent years.

**All aspirants who are Children/Wards of NRI including those who participated in written examination conducted by NIFT but could not be shortlisted for second stage i.e. Situation Test and GD&PI may participate in the process.**

**Academic Eligibility:** All candidates must satisfy the required academic qualifications as indicated in the Prospectus of Admission 2017.

The procedure to be adopted for allocation of seats would be as;

- First, preference will be given to the candidate who appeared in the written test held on 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2017, but were not shortlisted for 2nd level of entrance test. These candidates will appear only for interview on the scheduled date and will be ranked accordingly.
- The remaining vacant seats, if any, will be offered to the fresh candidates who have applied in response to this notice / advertisement. The admission of these applicants will be based on their performance in the written test and personal interview.

**MANDATORY DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ALLOTMENT OF SEAT UNDER NRI SEATS UNDER CHILDREN/WARDS OF NRI CATEGORY**

All candidates holding a merit rank will be given the option of availing the vacant seats of NRI under the category “**Children/Wards of NRI**” on the day of counselling, subject to submission of the following:

- Undertaking to be signed by the NRI/Foreign National (**Annexure VIII**)
- Photocopy of the passport of the NRI/Foreign National who is signing the undertaking which is attested by the Indian Consulate of the Embassy of the country where he/she is residing.
- Demand Draft of Rs.7,24,200/- (Rupees Seven lakh twenty four thousand and two hundred only) in favour of NIFT H.O. payable at the city in which candidate is attending the counselling. (For example: ***in case you are attending the counselling at NIFT Mumbai , DD should be made in favour of NIFT-HO Payable at Mumbai***)
- All the other Certificates / Degree and Undertakings.

The participation in the Counselling Session is mandatory, along with the requisite documents and demand draft mentioned above. ***In case candidate or his/her authorized representative fail to attend the Counselling Session, it will be presumed that he/she is not interested in our offer of admission and he/she will not be eligible for admission.***

Please note that, if the final result of the qualifying certificate/degree (the minimum prescribed qualification for eligibility for admission to this programme) has not been declared, the candidate may submit an undertaking (Annexure-I) on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.10/- for seeking provisional admission at the time of Counselling. The undertaking is to ensure that results of the qualifying certificate/degree shall be submitted latest by 30th September, 2017, failing which the candidature of the candidate shall be cancelled and the fee deposited with NIFT at the time of Counselling shall be forfeited.

## **OTHER DOCUMENTS AND ANNEXURES REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING / ADMISISON:**

After allotment of seat, the candidate will be required to deposit the requisite fee of Rs.7,24,200/- (Rupees Seven lakh twenty four thousand and two hundred only) Demand Draft in favour of NIFT H.O. payable at city in which the candidate is attending the Counselling. Having deposited the requisite amount by the candidate, he/she will be required to produce the following documents/certificates in original for verification with a set of attested photocopies. The original documents will be returned after verification:

Certificate of having passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination, showing the subjects offered by him/her in the examination. Physics, Chemistry and Math for B.F. Tech.
Certificate from the Board from which he/she passed the High School/Higher Secondary Examination
Fee – Demand Draft of Rs. 7,24,200/- drawn in favour of the NIFT HO payable at the Campus of the Counselling
Copy of 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> & 3 <sup>rd</sup> year graduation mark sheet/ self-attested copy of final year appearing certificate <b>(For Master Programmes)</b>
Undertaking for the candidate seeking provisional admission- <b>(Annexure-I)</b>
Undertaking from the students, as per provisions of anti-ragging <b>(Annexure-II)</b>
Undertaking about Eligibility, Fee and Refund <b>(Annexure IV)</b>
Medical Fitness Certificate in prescribed format <b>(Annexure VI)</b>

## **ADMISSION COUNSELLING AND REFUND**

- For participating in the rounds of Counselling, all eligible candidates will be required to register themselves online at [www.nift.ac.in](http://www.nift.ac.in). Candidates may register using their credentials i.e. Form Number, Date of Birth and Password. They are advised to remember and safely store their password for future references. Candidates would be required to select a Counselling campus from where he / she would participate in the Counselling. It may be the nearest NIFT Campus convenient for the candidate.
- On successful registration, a candidate will receive “system generated letter”, SMSs and e-mails on their registered mobile and email ids. The letter will contain the details of the Nodal Officer and the documents required for Counselling and admission.
- On the day of Counselling, the candidate is required to report at the chosen NIFT Campus at 9.30AM for verification of documents and allotment of seats. The original documents would be returned after due verification. Please note that the presence of the candidate or his / her authorized representative at any of the NIFT Campuses along with the requisite documents in original is mandatory. In case, the candidate or his/her authorized representative fail to attend the Counselling session, it will be presumed that he/she is not interested in NIFT's offer of admission and therefore will not be eligible for admission. At the time of Counselling, the Campus/Course /Category-wise seat availability chart will be displayed at all NIFT Campuses. Only the candidate/representative would be allowed into the Counselling hall. He / she would be called in order of the merit rank and offered the seat available at that point of time.
- After verification of the documents, allocation of seats will take place before the Nodal Officer of the Counselling Campus. The candidate or the authorized representative may select a seat by clicking on the monitor in the presence of the Nodal Officers. Seat allotted accordingly to a candidate would then be deleted from the pool of vacant seats displayed on the Campus screen. Candidates are advised to be present in the Counselling hall and wait for their call in order of their common merit rank. If a candidate is found unavailable when called, the next candidate on the merit rank would be called for allotment of seat and the unavailable candidate may miss his chance of merit-based seat allotment.

- After allotment of seat, candidate will be issued an allotment letter /receipt duly signed by the Nodal Officer of the Campus. The choice of Course / Campus made by the candidate / representative is final and binding and cannot be altered later under any circumstances.
- Candidates should ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility requirements mentioned in the Prospectus before they report for Counselling. The physical presence of the candidate at the time of Counselling is mandatory. If a candidate is unable to be physically present for the Counselling due to unavoidable circumstances, he / she may authorize another individual to represent him / her at the Counselling. The authorized representative must carry all the relevant documents and the full fee amount as well as the duly filled in Authorization Form (Annexure VII). Absence of the candidate or his / her representative at the indicated reporting venue may result in the forfeiture of his / her claim for a seat as per his / her merit rank.

#### **WITHDRAWAL OF ALLOTTED SEAT AND REFUND OF FEE**

A candidate, who has taken admissions but would like to cancel his / her allotted seat, may seek for the refund of fee as per the Refund Policy as placed on NIFT's website [www.nift.ac.in](http://www.nift.ac.in) . For this, he / she will have to report personally for withdrawal and refund at the same Campus where admission was obtained.
