(b) For each question, candidate will choose the option(s) corresponding to (all) the correct answer(s) (c) Answer to each question will be evaluated according to the following scheme; (i) Full Marks: +2 if only (all) the correct option(s) is (are) chosen (ii) Partial Marks: +1.5 if all the four options are correct but ONLY three correct options are chosen. (iii) Partial Marks: +1 If three or more options are correct but ONLY two options are chosen, both of which are correct. (iv) Partial Marks: +0.5 If two or more options are correct but ONLY one option is chosen and it is correct option. (v) Zero Marks: 0 if none of the option is chosen (i.e the question is unanswered). - (iv) If (d), [(a) & (d)] or [(b) & (d)], [(c) & (d)], [(a), (b), (d)], [(b), (c), (d)], [(a), (c), (d)], [(a), (b), (c), (d)] are chosen = - 0.25 marks
- (v) If question is unanswered = 0 marks
